The most important thing that can be said about this man Caleb was said three times in this chapter. The most important thing that can be said about any man is what was said about Caleb.

Israel had left Egypt and Caleb was 40 years old when they arrived in Kadesh Barnea on the southern border of Canaan. Tell the story about the spies. *Numbers 13, 14*

Caleb was the first to speak out for God and believing His promises. All those who did not believe died in the wilderness only Caleb and His friend Joshua were left. More than 600,000 people had died but they were spared, why? They wholly followed the Lord.

Caleb had faith in God. He was not ashamed to stand up for God, He was not afraid of the devil's agents. His confidence was in the Lord.

He was willing to drive out the Canaanites in Hebron 45 years ago but because of the unbelief of the people he could not.

The time finally came when he saw the desire of his heart. His faithfulness was rewarded and he was able to inherit the land where the figs grew. The milk and the honey. He was just as strong as ever and his faith never wavered.

Conclusion: Don't you know that God is the same today the same God that helped Joshua and Caleb is just as able and faithful today. You may be 40 or 85 but your strength in God need never weaken but you can take a mountain for God today.

Faith in God is your strength and doubt and fear is your greatest weakness.
