This eighth chapter of Romans pictures the highest experience one can have this side of heaven.

It reveals the sanctified man under all conditions of life as a victorious man. The first verse expresses this.

"There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit". Here is a soul no longer bothered by a double nature; no longer with a spirit in opposition to the law of God; but a soul following one Master, and he the Spirit of God. Up until this time two great principles embodied in laws have been working against each other, bringing wretchedness into his life. (See Romans 7:21-23). Now another law comes in and takes over. It is "the law of the spirit of life in Christ Jesus," and it has delivered from both the law which revealed sin and the law which brought death.

The law of God which was holy, just, and good, by its restraints was always trying to make men holy; but because of carnality it could not. What the law could not do, Jesus Christ has done by condemning to death that which opposed the working of the law of God in man's life. "For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh"

It does not put one where he will not have to keep his body under. (Romans 8:13).

It does not put one where he will not ever again have to suffer: but it does give him a hope in his suffering. Romans 8:13

It does give him hope that some day his suffering will all be over. (Romans 8:19-25).

It does not save one from infirmities. (Romans 8:26) But it does give him a source of help in his infirmities.



It does not save from temptation. It is no sin to be tempted; the sin is in yielding.

It does not save us from native timidity. Perfect love does not cast out all kinds or degrees of fear. It does cast out fear of the judgment and of meeting God. Native timidity is no sign of a lack of grace, and native boldness is no sign of any degree of grace.

It does not save us from being different from others in our ~~demonstrations~~ formation or expression of ideas.

It does not save us from being different from others in our demonstrations.

It does not save one from imperfect actions while possessing perfect intentions. Actions may be colored by circumstances, early training, early draining, mental attitudes or physical disability, while the intentions are perfectly pure.

It does save one from all sin, both actual and inborn, and provides a settlement of the sin question in Jesus Christ and his blood.

## God of the Birds

To C P clc 3-10-85

We have just come through the time of year when the birds begin to sing after a winter of silence. God has made so many different kinds. The Bible refers to 40 different species of birds. Jesus said in Matthew 6:26 "Behold the fowls of the air". It is very important in the study of the Bible to notice the many references about natural history. 593 times the Bible referred to it.

The first sound that struck the human ear may have been the sound of a bird's voice.

The raven and the dove were used by Noah to see if the earth was dried up.

When Jesus was baptized the Holy Spirit descended on Him in the form of a dove.

David with Saul after him says: "I am hunted as a partridge on the mountains." And speaking of his forlorn condition he says: "I am like a pelican of the wilderness." Also in referring to his loneliness he says: "I am a swallow alone on a housetop."

When Hezekiah was emaciated by sickness he compares himself to a crane, thin and wasted.

When Job had so much trouble he could not sleep nights he says: "I am a companion to owls."

Jeremiah describing the cruelty of parents who leave their children to the ostrich who leaves its eggs in the sand uncared for, crying: "The daughter of my people is become like the ostriches of the wilderness."

The Lord taught the children of Israel a lesson in the wilderness by giving them quail for breakfast.

The prophet in illustrating the waywardness of his people says: "The stork knoweth her appointed time and the turtle and the crane and the swallow the time of their going, but my people know not the judgements of the Lord." The word "stork" ordinarily means mercy and affection distinguished for its great love to its parents.

The prophet describing the church cries out: "Mine heritage is unto me as a speckled bird, the birds round



about are against her." So it was then; so it is now. Holiness picked at. consecration picked at. Usefulness picked at. A speckled bird is a peculiar bird, and arouses the beakes of the forest. Christ intended the the church should remain a speckled bird. But like the albatross, she can sleep on the bosom of a pempest. She has gone through the fires of Nebuchadnezzar's furnace and not got burnt Through the waters of the Red Sea and not been drowned, through the shipwreck on the breakers of Melita and not been lost. Let all earth and hell try to hunt down this speckled bird. but the gates of hell shall not prevail against her."

God compares his treatment of his people to the eagle's care of the eaglets. Deut. 32:11 "As an eagle stirreth up her nest, fluttereth over her young, spreadeth abroad her wings, taketh them, beareth them on her wings, so the Lord alone did nead him."

It was thought in ancient times that an eagle could not only molt his feathers in old age, but that after arriving to great age he would renew his strength and become entirely young again. To Isaiah refers when he says: "They that wait on the Lord shall renew their strength, they shall mount up with wings as eagles."

In refereng to the brevity of life Job says: "Swift as an eagle that hasteth to its prey."

Jesus said, as a hen gathers her chick under her wings, so he wants to gather us. When danger comes, such as a hawk flying overhead. The mother hen gives a funny little sound and the luttile chickens come running and she spreads her wings over them. The little chick sometimes peak out but if they are wise they will stay until all dager is past. If we want safety we must stay close to Jesus.

Twenty times the Bible refers to birds nests in showing the wonderous care of God for His people.

Over fifty times does the old Book refere to the wing, "Wings of a dove, Wings of the morning, Wings of the wind,, Sun of righteousness with healing in his wings," Wings of the Almighty,"

What does it all mean? That man should go upword. We must get ready for our flight from this earth to glory.
