Intro. The Saviour has been away a long time, but in His love letter, the Bible, He tells us that He is coming back. We don't know when it will be, maybe today, maybe tomorrow, maybe a hundred or a thousand years from now. But He is coming and we have a right to look for Him in our lifetime. The Bible teaches us that his coming is imminent, that is, He may come at any moment. *Now read script*

The people of the Old testament looked forward to His coming. Then when He did come many didn't recognize Him. "He came to His own and His own received Him not" John 1:11.

II The Time of His coming

Judge Rutherford, founder of the Jeshovah's Witness sect, said that He came in 1914, but that His coming was spiritual and that no one saw Him But the Bible says, "Behold, he cometh with clouds, and every eye shall see him."

Some seventh Day Adventists said that He was coming in 1844. They sold their farms or gave them away, they put on their white robes and gathered on the mountain tops and waited for Him. But they were dirsappointed.

Bible scholars have tried to determine the exact date but they are waisting their tome because the Bible says no one knows not even the angels in heaven.

Some years ago a group of people used this slogan, "Millions Now living May never Die."

III. The Effects of His coming

IV The Challenge of His coming

Listen to Luke 21:34 "And take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and so that day come upon us unawares."

Maybe there is some secret sin in your life.
You may have some ill feeling in your heart toward someone.
Maybe you are behind in paying your tithe. You ought to square that account, for Jesus is coming.

Sinners need to get ready for His coming. You must turn from your sin and trust Him as your personal Saviour. "He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life; and he that

believeth not the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abideth on Him" John 3:36.

He went away in the clouds and is coming back in the clouds.

He came as a tiny baby to Bethlehem. He is coming back with power and glory.

His coming will be sudden. "For as the lightning cometh out of the East and shineth even unto the West, so shall the coming of the Son of man be." Matt. 24:27. Like the twinkling of an eye 1 Cor. 15:52. We have many things in this life

that we can prepare for and have advance notice just when it will happen. The weather man tells us about storms,

tornado watches and warnings, heavy rains and snows but the coming of Jesus will be without advance warning.

In the book of Rev. ch. 16:15 we read, "Behold, I come as a thief. Blessed is he that watcheth, and keepeth his garments, lest he walk naked, and they see his shame. Also Rev. 3:11 "Behold, I come quickly, hold fast which thou hast, that no man take thy crown."

When Jesus comes again there will be no time to get ready to meet Him. It will be as fast as lightning and as fast as blinking yo ur eye. He will come as fast as the speed of light 186,000 MPS

The Bible has much to say about the importance of keeping ready for his coming. because there will be no time when He comes to prepare, "Therefore, be ye also ready for in such an hour as ye think not, the son of man cometh."

Do you think He will come today? No you probably say, Will He come tomorrow? Next week, Next year? We have no advance notice. The sky will look the same as it always has, we will be doing, the ordinary things of life when He comes.

Illus. One great man of God was asked what he would do today if he knew the Lord was coming. He said, "I would do just what I had planned to do, so you see he felt sure he was doing what God wanted him to do."

Illus. I heard a preacher say one time when I was a boy that christians had so many differences, grudges, hard feelings, and misunderstandings that before they can go all the way to heaven they will meet the Lord in the air, and get all these things straightened out so they will be ready for heaven. The trouble with that idea is that there is no place in the Bible where there is any teaching like that. We are to live in perfect obedience to the Lord now. I Tim. 6:14 says, "That thou keep this commandment without spot, unrebukable until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ."

We are to live in joyful expectation, "Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ."

Illus. During the Korean War I read that many of the Christians were so persecuted that they often prayed that the Lord would come quickly, Illus. told to bring sacks to church. This is true of Christians living under communism. We have Gods blessing if we live as it says in Heb. 9:28 "unto them that look for Him shall He appear the second time without sin unto salvation."

We should be constantly abiding in Him. "And now, little children, abide in Him; that when He shall appear, we may have confidence, and not be ashamed before him at his coming."

Now lets see what will happen at this time. "Then shall two be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left. Two women shall be grinding at the mill; the one shall be taken and the other left. Watch therefore; for ye know not what hour your Lord doth come." Matt 24:40-42

the great separation

"For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God; and the dead in Christ shall rise first, then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air and so shall we ever be with the Lord." 1 Thes. 4:16.

Wherefore comfort one another with the word,
This will be a great meeting in the air. What a great time of rejoicing that will be when we are reunited with loved ones that have been dead for many years. Illus. Dad, Mother, Brother, Brother-in-law. *Juanita wife husband.*

It will be a sad day for those that are left behind. those who are not ready will have to live with murders, theives, drunkards, selfish, liars, homosexuals, fornicators to name a few.

The best thing we can do is to be honest with God, repent of our sins, make things right with God and our fellow men, then live daily so that we will be ready when He comes.

The next thing that may come to our minds is the question, when is He coming? How long will we have to wait? What day and what hour? Many people have tried to answer that question but have failed to come up with the right answer. On ~~the~~ Oct. 22, 1844 a certain religious group believed the Lord would return. They believed it so strongly that many sold their property and dressed up in white robes and stood up on top of hay stacks and the roofs of houses waiting for ~~the~~ Lord to come. They waited all day untill the sun went down but He didn't come. If they had read Matt. 24:36 they would have known that He wouldn't come then for it says: "But of that day and hour knoweth no man, ~~not~~ not the angels of heaven, but my Father only." This was Jesus speaking. Also 1 Thes. 5:2 "For yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so cometh as a thief in the night."
