Conviction for sin, which is a form of suffering, comes to produce repentance, which is absolutly necessary to beace and pardon, Happy is the sinner who is thus called upon to suffer. It may become the door to eternal life. Some are so convicted that they cannot sleep or eat. . radions diliw worros lo

There is the suffering caused by inbred sin - this internal warring with a foreign enemy whom we willingly harbor. This suffering is a painful call to deliver this man of sin the carnal mind to the Holy Executioner, that the soul may have peace and rest in God, which can be obtained in no other Way. (22:21 . tttk) With a daying very vleyoveing at redduction

She had assumed the problem as her own and made petition There is the suffering of the Christian because of blunders errors, and faults. This suffering is given to us for corrective purposes. In this field are the rebukes and reproofs from God's messengers, as well as the chastening of the Lord. They are given that we may be led to "confess your faults one to another" and thereby keep reconciled to God and to man. God's chastening is to enlarge the soul's capacity and to fill it with His holiness. One should rejoice in such moments of fruit-bearing suffering.

There is the suffering that comes with normal growth or expansion pains. In youth, they are called "growing pains." They are the opening up of the personality, the enlargement of the soul, and the deepening of the Christian life, It is like the opening up of "new ground" for the farmer's expanding field for cultivation.

Suffering that is of benefit to others beregues ed of wildred

Suffering for truth's sake. Paul felt the sting of such when he said, "Am I therefore become your enemy, because I tell you the truth?" Love must be in deed and in truth," and the truth is painful at times. But love will suffer the pain of whatever unfavorable reation to the truth my come, for it is dedicated to the truth. Here the truth is the primary beneficiary.

There is suffering for Godlikeness. This is enevitable:
"Because ... I have chosen you out of the world, therefore
the world hateth you" (John 15:19). Righteousness produces
pain in the unrepentant sinner and it often reacts as suffering in the Christian. Here righteousness is exalted, God is
honored, and the suffering saint rewarded.

There is the suffering of comradship "Weep with them that weep" is taught by God and was practiced by His Son while upon earth. In a common suffering the Christian bounds are strengthened and the mutual participation divided the load of sorrow with another.

There is the suffering of intercession when one feels the sinner's plight as his own and pleads for himself as the guilty. The woman from canaan illustrates this type. He petition was "Have mery on me O Lord. thou son of David; my daughter is grievously vexed with a devil" (Matt. 15:22). She had assumed the problem as her own and made petition for herself. The prayer was rewarded.

The Holy Spirit, who "Maketh intersession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered" (Rom. 8:26). Represents the highest possible form of such suffering. Christ also ministered here. I aiah tells us that "He hat borne our griefs, and carried our sorrowm" (Isa. 53:4) He made our sins His own and "was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our oniquities" (v.5).

To a large degree, the Apostle Paul entered this field, declaring. "I... now rejoice in my sufferings for you. and fill up that which is behind of the afflictions of Christ in my flesh for his body's sake, which is the church" (Col. 1:24)

Such a ministry might be looked upon as morbid and depressing. but for the fact that it is sppported by joy. Paul tells upon that he rejoiced in his suffering. On another occasion, he said, "Most gladly therefore with I rather glory in my infiemities... I take pleasure...in reproaches, in necessities, in persecutions, in distresses for Christ's sake" (2Cor. 12:9-10)s

Such suffering is the birth pains of new lives. Paul puts it this way: "My little children, of whom I travail in birth again until Christ be formed in you" (Gal. 4:19).

To the Thessalonians he wrote, "Ye remember... opur labout and travail" (1 Thess. 2:9). The promise made to Jesus "He shall see of the travail of his soul, and shall be satisfied will be sahred by all who thus suffer. "Your labour is not in wain in the Lord" (2 Cor. 15:58).
