Our example Jesus. He went everywhere doing good. We must seek opportunities for doing good to our fellow men.
 - B. A church without works is dead, but the works must be honored and blessed by God.
 - C. The members of the church must be surrendered to God if they are going to shine for him.
- II. Must have strength.
 - A. The church at Philadelphia had a little strength, the kind of strength that was approved by God.
 1. We are strong only if each one of us have a close relationship with God.
 2. We must be strong in prayer and faith and love, if we are to succeed.
- III. Keep My word.
 - A. The church with an open door must treasure the word of God. His word must be honored and respected above everything else.
 - B. The word must be preached and the word must be lived by each of us.
 - C. Evil must not be allowed to creep into the church. When this happens it always brings the disapproval of God.
 - D. We must be a full gospel church preaching and teaching and living close to the word of God. This brings victory.
 - IV. Don't deny God's name.
 - A. We can deny the Lord by being ashamed of Him and His work and people.
 - B. We can deny Him by failing to use what abilities we have in His service.
