Seven Steps to Backsliding *Trace Jan 12/56*

Levensmore 1-6-95

Text: "But he began to curse and to swear, saying, I know not this man of whom ye speak" (Mark 14 71).

Intro: Backsliding is a process. Eve, first "saw" then "desired", then "took".

So we may trace Peter's fall step by step. Let us examine our own hearts in the light of the tragic events in Peter's downward descent.

I. Step one: *Conceit*

a. Self-confidence. Peter said, "although all should be offended yet will not I" (v.29)

II. Step two:

A. Boasting. "If I should die with thee, I will not deny thee, in any wise" (V.31). "So said they all, but Peter spake the more vehemently."

III. Step Three. *Easy*

A. Unwatchfulness. He said unto Peter, "Simon, sleepest thou" (V. 37). Sleepy souls are easy marks for Saton's temptations.

IV. Shame. "Peter followed him afar off" (V. 54)

A. Christ was now less popular with the croud, Peter follos but not near enough to be identified with Him. Ashamed to bear the reproach of Christ.

V. Step five: *Evil associations*

A. Wordliness. Peter sat with the servants, and warmed himself at the fire (V.54). After falling out of step with Christ, it now becomes natural to "Warm" at the fire of the "world."

VI. Step six

A. Denial. The natural consequence of self confidence, boasting, lethargy, and worldliness is "Denial."

The world and the Devil will surely put the pressure on. and fore you to confess or deny Christ.

VII. Step Seven:

"Hebgegin to curse and to swear, saying, I know not this man." Back to the old life return to the house that is now swept and garnished. the devils return.

Conclusion; The cure for backsliding.

The old year is almost past and soon we will begin a new year. I sometimes think of when I used to hand out report card to the kids in school. Some students had done very well and others had failed. I often told the ones that had failed not to despair you cannot change what you have already ~~have~~ done but now you have the chance to make good before the next report card is made out. We cannot change the past year but by Gods grace we can make this the best year of our lives.

The apostle Paul has a scripture for us this morning: Philippians 3:10-14 "That I may know Him, and the power of his resurrection, and the fellowship of his sufferings, being made conformable unto his death; if by any means I might attain unto the resurrection of the dead. Not as though I had already attained, either were already perfect: but I follow after, if that I may apprehend that for which also I am apprehended of Christ Jesus. Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended; but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before, I press toward the mark for the prize of the High calling of God in Christ Jesus."

Verse 13 says "Forgetting those things which are behind" In order for us to be at our best for God there are some things we must forget;

First of all we need to forget injustices done to us. We may have been mistreated and falsely accused but just remember Jesus was too and we are not greater than our Lord.

He set an example for us by going about everywhere doing good in spite of his many enemies. He said "Love your enemies do good to them that hate you and despitefully use you." He sends the rain on the just and the unjust.

What a wonderful example for us to follow. as Christian workers we have to expect persecutions. Jesus said "All that live Godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution." We all like to have all men speak well of us but know matter how good you are there will be some people that will give you a hard time, because they are led by their father the devil and his job is to accuse the brethren day and night

Heartaches take them all to Jesus
He will take your heartaches all away

Let us follow the example of Jesus who ~~even~~ when hanging on the cross saved a poor thief hanging beside Him.

The apostle Paul had a wonderful spirit of forgetting wrongs done to him and reaching out to the needs of others. Some people say well I will forgive but I can't forget. We remember what we dwell on in our mind. There are some things that may be hard for us to understand and it may take some effort on our part to forget, but it can be done by God's grace to the extent that it doesn't bother us any more and we don't waste time and energy mulling over it in our mind. The fact of the matter is we must forgive and forget if we want to have a healthy mind, spirit and body. Harboring injustices and grudges brings about self destruction.

We need to forget to feel sorry for ourself. The Devil harps on this tune all the time. Like a song we heard several years ago, "Sing me one of those some one done somebody wrong songs". Feeling sorry for your self has wrecked more homes and churches than anything I know of. Not only that but it makes the person who feels sorry very unhappy and depressed. If we will think of the needs of others more we will have less time to pity ourselves.

We need to forget past failures. It's true we learn by our failures, but we can also be defeated by our failures. Many great men and women have had lots of failures but have not let them get them down. Thomas Edison while working to make an electric light bulb filament that would not burn out quickly tried a thousand different materials before he found the right substance. One of the men who worked with him asked him why he didn't quit, he said well I have tried all these things that haven't worked so now we are closer to succeeding than we were when we started. His secret for success was, lots of hard work and courage to not give up.

Some things about this past year may have seemed to you a complete loss but tomorrow will be a new day and a new year.

We need to forget to doubt and fear. Jesus said many times fear not. Remember if God be for us, who can be against us. There is nothing to fear if God is on our side, and we know He is on our side if we love and obey Him. Doubt and fear brings unbelief and unbelief brings sin.

Jesus said to his disciples, Why are ye so fearful, how is it that ye have no faith. He also said "Without faith it is impossible to please God. We can be so paralyzed by fear that it is impossible to work or enjoy life at all. *He that feareth is not made perfect in love.*

There is something else Paul brings out in this passage of scripture, in verse 14 he says "I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus. We cannot live in the past we must keep pressing on, like the song "I'm pressing on the upward way, new heights I'm gaining every day. still praying as I onward bound, Lord plant my feet on higher ground. My soul has no desire to stay, where doubts arise and fears dismay, tho some may dwell where these abound, my prayer my aim is higher ground. Lord lift me up and let me stand, by faith on heavens table land, a higher plain than I have found, Lord plant my feet on higher ground."

There are several ways we need to keep pressing on toward the Glory land. 925

We need to press on in greater faith. in 1987 our faith should be stronger than in 1984. Lets keep pressing on and believe God for faith brings the victory. "This is the victory that overcomes the world even our faith". *You cannot be a good Christian without a strong faith.*

We need to press on in love and devotion, In the 13th ch. of I Cor. Paul writes, about many thing that will fail but he says Love never faileth. We may not have as much natureal ability as other people have, but we all can show love to God and others, Real love For others is what has the best results in winning others to the Lord, without real love we are sounding brass or a tinkling symbol. In order to have this Godly love we must spend time in prayer and maditation with the Lord, Only God can help us to love others as we should.

The last way I want to mention we should keep pressing on is in greater sacrifice for the Lord and His gospel. Romans ch. 12 says we are to present our bodies a living sacrifice wholly acceptable unto God which is our reasonable service. How much have we really sacrificed for the Lord this past year. So many people want God to do great things for them but they never seem to realize that Gods work suffers unless they are willing to give of their time talents and money for the precious gospel.

Let us follow the example of Jesus who even when hanging
on the cross, prayed for his persecutors. This tells us that
God has promised that if we would give to him he will bless
us abundantly.

Lets make this the best year we have ever had by obeying
God and letting Him lead us every step of the way. We
know not what the future holds, but we know God holds
the future. and we know that all things will work together
for our good if we love and obey him praise His wonderful
name.
